Dear Friends,

As I write this, I am looking out on an ice-covered yard and street, grateful for the sun doing its work melting the ice so we can safely be back together. I am grateful as well for the road crews, power crews, and first responders who have been working around the clock through this storm to keep us warm and safe! I grew up in Florida without seasons, and one of the things I love about North Carolina is that we get just enough of all four seasons. I must admit, though, that by the third day of ice, part of me is ready for Spring! Being apart on Sunday was a reminder of the power of connection when we gather together, and I give thanks for the community of the church.

Later this month, we will move into the liturgical season of Lent. We'll put ash crosses on our foreheads on Ash Wednesday (February 18), we'll pull out the purple adornments in our worship spaces, maybe you will give something up for 6 weeks, and we'll probably sing in a minor key more than we do the rest of the year.

In this season of Lent, we are getting ready for Easter. Beginning with Ash Wednesday, Lent is the 40-day (not including Sundays) period of preparation for Easter – one of the most important celebrations in the life of the church.

Often, we think of Lent as a time to give something up. Abstaining from something we enjoy during Lent is a form of the Christian practice of fasting. Fasting turns our attention away from our own desires and focuses it on God. Fasting also creates space for us to deepen our relationship with God.

Though the 40 days of Lent might seem like an eternity, fasting doesn't happen forever. The Christian life is a rhythm of fasts and feasts, each just as important as the other. Lent is a season of getting ready. All of our fasting in this season; all of our self-denial; all of our penitence and self-examination; all of our creating space for and focusing our desires on God; all of this gets us ready for the grandest celebration of new life that the world has ever known.

We can't gloss over the fast, whatever that looks like for you. You may choose to give something up, to add a more intentional prayer practice, to fast from food or meat one day a week, or simply to adopt a spirit of reflection. Easter needs preparation. Our hearts need this time of examination to grasp the miracle of Easter. But when you soon see flowers braving the frost; when you pack your coat up and take it out again, know that life is ahead.

I pray your fast is holy, that your feast may be glorious.
